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1. Introduction

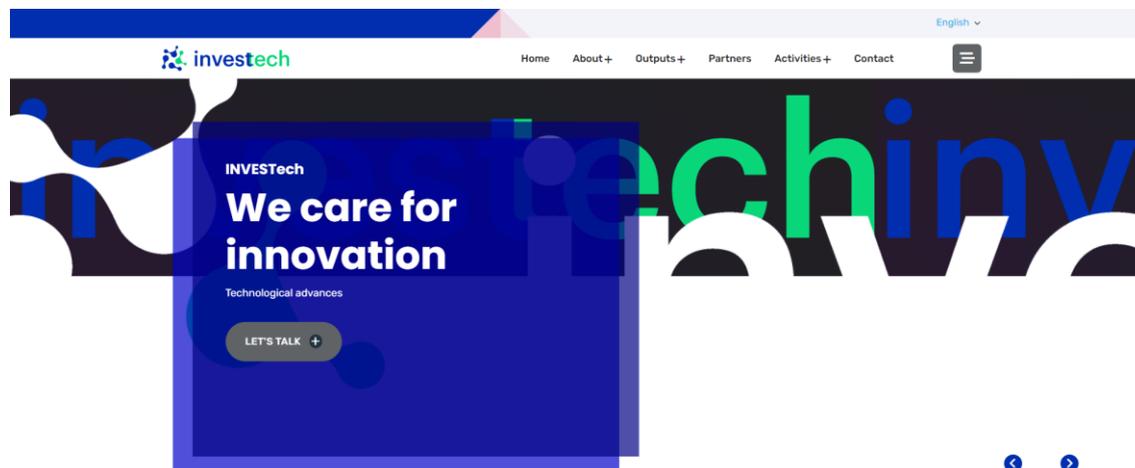

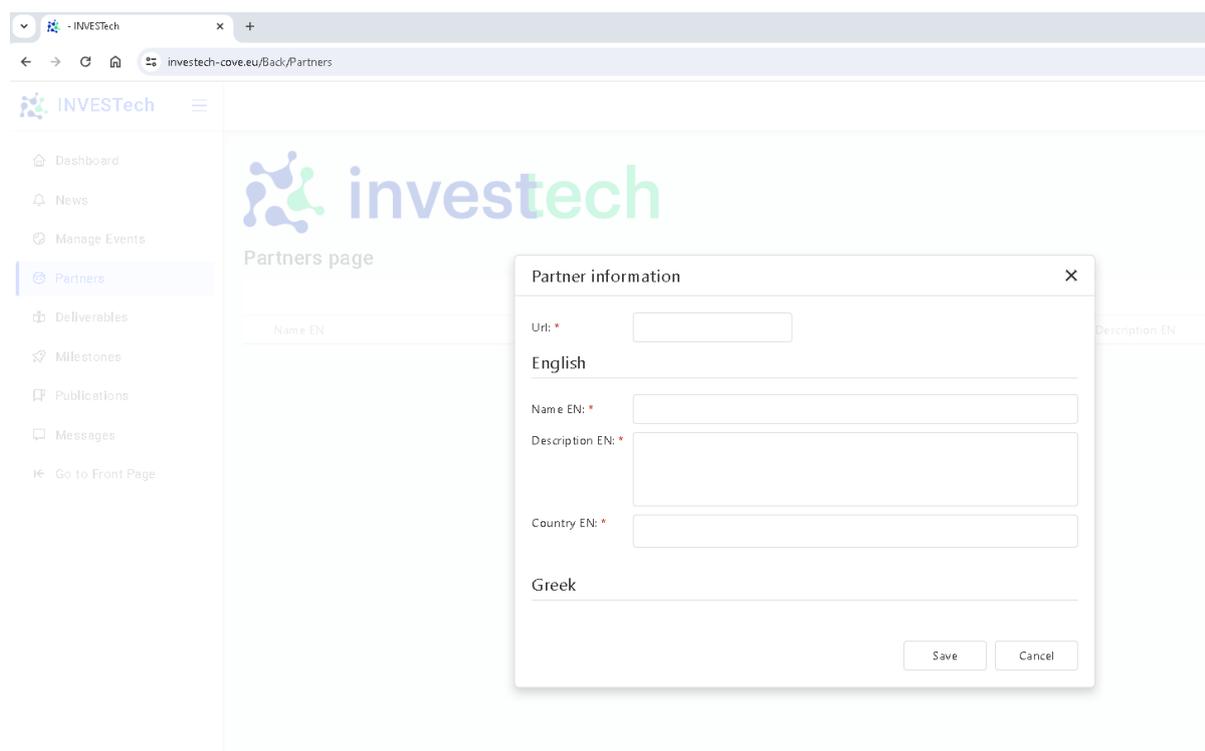


This is how the dashboard of the CMS looks like to the user when authenticated.



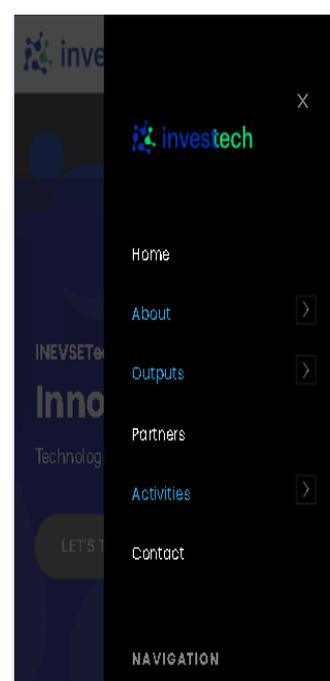
Here the user will be able to see the messages sent by the visitors in the contact us section.
